• Must be at least 18 years of age
• Must have at minimum a high school diploma (or the equivalent)
• Must hold a current adult CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and AED (automated external defibrillator) certificate including live skills check *
*CPR and AED are both required in the US and Canada. Candidates outside the US and Canada are required to hold only current CPR due to differing laws regarding AED use by non-medical professionals in some countries.
